#### 4. COMPETITION RULES

---

<b>Competition Rules</b>	WTF / VTB competition rules
<b>Forms</b>	Taegeuk and higher WTF / Kukkiwon poomsae
<b>Mode</b>	<p>1) Athletes shall be allowed to compete in more divisions: Individual Division, Team Division, Pair Division.</p> <p>2) Cut-off system for Dangrades:  <b>1<sup>st</sup> round:</b> all competitors (<b>+18 competitors</b>).  <b>2<sup>nd</sup> round:</b> at least 50% of the competitors (<b>9-17</b>) (including participants with equal scores) (possibility for extra rounds in case of equal scores to qualify for the finals).  <b>3<sup>rd</sup> round:</b> maximum of <b>8 competitors</b> (highest scores) can qualify for this round.  <b>4<sup>th</sup> round:</b> after equal score: between 1 – 2 – 3 – 4 ranking.</p> <p>3) <b>8<sup>th</sup> Geup:</b> maximum four times the same Taegeuk.  <b>7<sup>th</sup> or 6<sup>th</sup> Geup:</b> maximum two the same Taegeuk.  <b>5<sup>th</sup> Geup and higher:</b> must give four different Taegeuk/Poomsae.</p> <p>4) <b>Number of rounds</b> for Geup-grades (according to the VTB-rules):  1) If maximum 5 participants: only third round  2) 6 to 10 participants: only first and third round  3) More than 10 participants: first, second and third round</p> <p>5) All compulsory Taegeuk/ Poomsae will be announced 1 day before the competition on the website: <a href="http://www.taekwondo.be">www.taekwondo.be</a></p>
<b>Doping Control</b>	Some contestants chosen at random will be tested. The list of prohibited products will be equal to the list of the IOC.
<b>Awards</b>	To all winners of 1 <sup>st</sup> , 2 <sup>nd</sup> and 3 <sup>rd</sup> place, cups will be awarded.
<b>Hall Rules</b>	Only the competitors and their coaches have admittance with their registration cards to the contest areas.
<b>Protest</b>	Must be made by the <b>official coach</b> within 10 minutes of the end of the contest to the Poomsae Referee Director. Protest fee is €150.
<b>Liability</b>	All competitors participate at their own risk. The organizers or the VTB shall not accept responsibility for any damages, injuries or losses sustained or incurred.

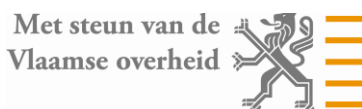
